making a wool lavender spray and felting a pin cushion in a small creamer creating a fall wreath



Rug Hooking Bag - led by Bev Ekstrand and Marsha Buckner

You will be hooking the front of this small bag. The bag has a zipper in the back and can be easily put together when hooking is finished. You will need to bring your frame, hook and scissors.

Wool Flowers - Pat Doughtery

In this class you will complete two wool flowers. Please bring frame, hook, and scissors.



Wool Lavender Spray & Felted Pin Cushion - led by Patty Wallace

This workshop has two projects. You will felt wool roving for a pin cushion in a small creamer and will also make a wool lavender spray. You will need to bring scissors.

Fall Wreath - led by Linda Harpham and Sandy Wiseman

We will use a wire wreath form and deco mesh to complete a fall wreath. You will need to bring scissors to cut the mesh.
